ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

The Anesthetists' Travel Club was founded by Dr. John S. Lundy in 1929. It continued under his personal influence, meeting annually through 1941. With the intervention of World War II, meetings were suspended through 1951. In his historical sketch, Dr. Lundy states that he then decided to reorganize the Club as the Academy of Anesthesiology. With his guidance, Dr. Roland J. Whitacre framed a proposed constitution and bylaws. These were introduced at the last meeting of the Club, in 1952, and unanimously adopted. (1: pp. 2-3.)

The Inaugural Meeting of the Academy of Anesthesiology was held in October, 1954. It was decided that membership should be by invitation only. The number of active members was limited to "a maximum of 60", plus "senior", non-voting members. A substantial portion of the dues were contributed annually to the Anesthesia Foundation (formerly the Anesthesia Memorial Foundation). (1: p. 6 and 2: p. 5.)

As proposed by Dr. Lundy, the Academy produced a handsome "Directory" of its members. This consisted of one or more pages of biographical and career information about each member, including a photograph and bibliography.

Memorabilia

An effort was made to have a group portrait taken at every meeting. Dr. Lundy's historical sketch states that attendees at the first meeting were given an aluminum ampoule holder as a souvenir, and that attendees at the second meeting were given an aluminum ruler "having a gauge for needles on it and a gauge for intratracheal tubes". There are examples of these personalized rulers in the Paul Wood and John Lundy Collections. The Academy archives also includes medallions that were made for various meetings.
