In the ABA Secretary-Treasurer space, Ralph M. Waters signed. This certificate was awarded to "Paul M. Wood," who cofounded the ABA and served as its secretary and eventually as its president. Drs. Lundy, Waters, and Wood had all helped transform the ABA from its earlier status as a subordinate board (of the American Board of Surgery) to a truly independent specialty board.
